

**Looking Through a Layman's
Lens: Recollections of
Rev. Fr. Jesús María Merino, O.P.**

Impressive. That was what he was to me that day he entered our Graduate School class. Briskly walking to the front, he flashed a general smile in greeting and began the class with a prayer. Pink-faced and slightly perspiring from his quick pace, he was dressed in a white Dominican habit with a black belt and rosary at the waist. Then he plunged right into the lesson on Native Religions of the Philippines with nary a hesitation.

Coming out of Arts and Letters that year, I and two other classmates went straight at the Graduate School for our Master's Degree. Despite my four years in UST as an undergraduate student, I have not had a single Dominican Professor. Which explains why I was sufficiently awed by my first Dominican mentor. Thus began tutelage under Rev. Fr. Jesús María Merino Antolínez, O.P.

To say that he knew the subject matter was an understatement. He breathed life into the description of a grand *cañao* with just the right solemnity of tone while enacting the measured movements of the high priest. I almost saw the ritual before me.

Being the Director of the UST Museum then, he opened it up, bidding us to come into its dark interiors of varied displays and curiosities that brought the light of knowledge to generations

of his students. There were headdresses, tools, weapons and ritual vessels – the field was right in the university and how. Fr. Merino explained the provenance of the pieces that awed us all the more. Whenever the need arose to visualize a utensil or a tool, we trekked to the museum for a quick look. I still think nothing today can beat the visual feast we partook of in the old museum.

His anthropological interests gave him very good skills to be part of Medical Missions in remote *barangays* regularly. Fr. Merino did not say this outright. We gathered it from his descriptions of people and topography of the provinces he visited and in his incidental mention of the medical missions.

Always considerate and kind to his students, there was not a single occasion that he did not oblige a request for a postponement of a deadline for paper submission even without a credible reason from the student. Our seminarian classmates prodded one “Sister” to make the request which – they said – guaranteed the deadline postponement. Yet one of the lay students just as quickly got his wish another time.

His cheerful demeanor and even-temperedness was nearly legendary among his students. No matter how many questions he was asked, he never showed impatience. And indeed, some queries were meant to poke fun at his response but he foiled the perpetrator by chuckling even more visibly at his own answer. During the almost two years I enjoyed his classes, I had never seen him lose his equanimity.

It is no wonder that he attracted his own band of disciples/followers who tailed him from the Seminary to the Graduate School, or from the Sisters’ Institute to the same place. You can see evidence of that as he passed the corridors – some would greet him and kiss his hand, others joyfully called out, “Father, hello!” And he would as joyfully return the greeting.

One of the sources of wonder and amusement about him by turns is his having never been seen wearing anything but white shirts, white socks and the Dominican habit. No trouser leg tips were visible at the hem of his habit, so it was fair game to imagine what he was wearing under it. As one of the handful of lay

students in his class, I was oblivious to that until that was brought to my attention by our classmates from the Seminary. Years later, I was pleasantly surprised to see Fr. Merino in real black trousers, a dark blue shirt with clerical collar, tucked in with black belt. More interestingly, he was lugging a suitcase and stored it at the boot of a car. It turned out that he left to present a paper somewhere in Europe. I confess to having told some former classmates about the unbelievable vision of a differently-clad Fr. Merino. Others graduated with the sole image of him in the Dominican habit. I laid claim to having seen him in a traveling get-up.

He had uneven hair length at the crown of his head. While deep into his lectures, he absentmindedly rubbed the top of his head bringing tufts of hair standing up or in curlicued formation. When he turned, they bent sideways then stuck up again. This went on for sometimes until one of the Sisters pointed it out to him. "Heh?", was his quizzical response. Then when he learned of it he quipped, "so I gave you a good time, ha?" He flattened the wayward tuft and continued the lecture.

Fr. Merino did not talk about himself. He did talk about the Dominican community activities, especially if an important guest is expected and a visit to the Museum was imminent. He spoke mostly of university activities outside the lessons so students inevitably were curious about him. One day (this again from a seminarian classmate!) we learned it was his birthday so we sang a hearty round of "happy birthday" when he arrived. He beamed in surprise and asked how we knew. He just nodded at our answer and thanked us. Then someone asked him his age. He answered by giving a clue. "I am now in a topsy-turvy age," smiling widely. After sometimes, one finally guessed right – he was then 69 years old.

If you need to tell him something, you need to say it fast right after class. Otherwise, he is off walking briskly back to the Father's Residence for dinner. Then you have to tell him what you have to all the while he is walking in full trot which has defeated others much younger than he was then. What a sight it was, Fr. Merino striding quickly with brief pauses to cross the driveways while a student (woe to a Sister or a lady) tries to explain as fast as

one walked while hanging on to books, notes, a bag or an umbrella. This was usual fare in his class but anyone watching would be entertained by it.

I hardly saw Fr. Merino after I settled down in 1993, specially after I was away for four years. When I saw him in 2001, I was surprised, glad and sad at the same time. Surprised and glad because I did not realize he was still with us but sad as well, because he needed caregivers by then. When I passed him in the right wing chapel pew I greeted him, "Good morning Father." He looked at me, nodded and raised his hand to bless me.

Rev. Fr. Jesus Merino, O.P. was true to his calling. He evangelized with his teaching and his life. He focused on the task at hand, fulfilling his responsibilities with cheer and dedication. He never was absent except once and even announced it before it happened. Professionalism was in every act, every word throughout our time with him. He did not just impart what he knew about Religion and Religions, but by his warm, personal example – he showed us what friars like him set out to do. I personally realized the great labor of all those who came before him in a long line from the past, contributing to the university that we are today. It is a humbling reminder of what we could do with each of us so placed here today. Through my layman's lens I will always recall Fr. Merino with great respect, gratitude and affection as all those like him richly deserve. □
